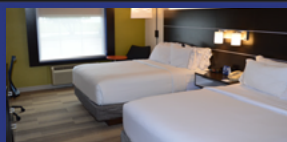

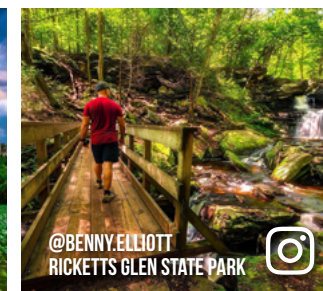

LOCATION

Conveniently located near Interstate 80 and State Routes 11, 487 and 42, the Columbia-Montour Counties region is easily accessible from any direction and has a welcome center located in Bloomsburg.

ROUTE 11

- In Bloomsburg
- Follow Route 11 until it intersects with Route 487
- Follow Route 487 North approximately 2 miles
- Turn left onto Papermill Road

ROUTE 487

- The Columbia-Montour Welcome Center is located at the intersection of Route 487 and Papermill Road, as it intersects I-80 at Exit 236.
- When traveling Route 487 South, take a right at Papermill Road (at the Sunoco Gas Station)
- Follow the Visitor Center signs

INTERSTATE 80

The Columbia-Montour Welcome Center is located at Exit 236 (Bloomsburg/Lightstreet) off I-80.

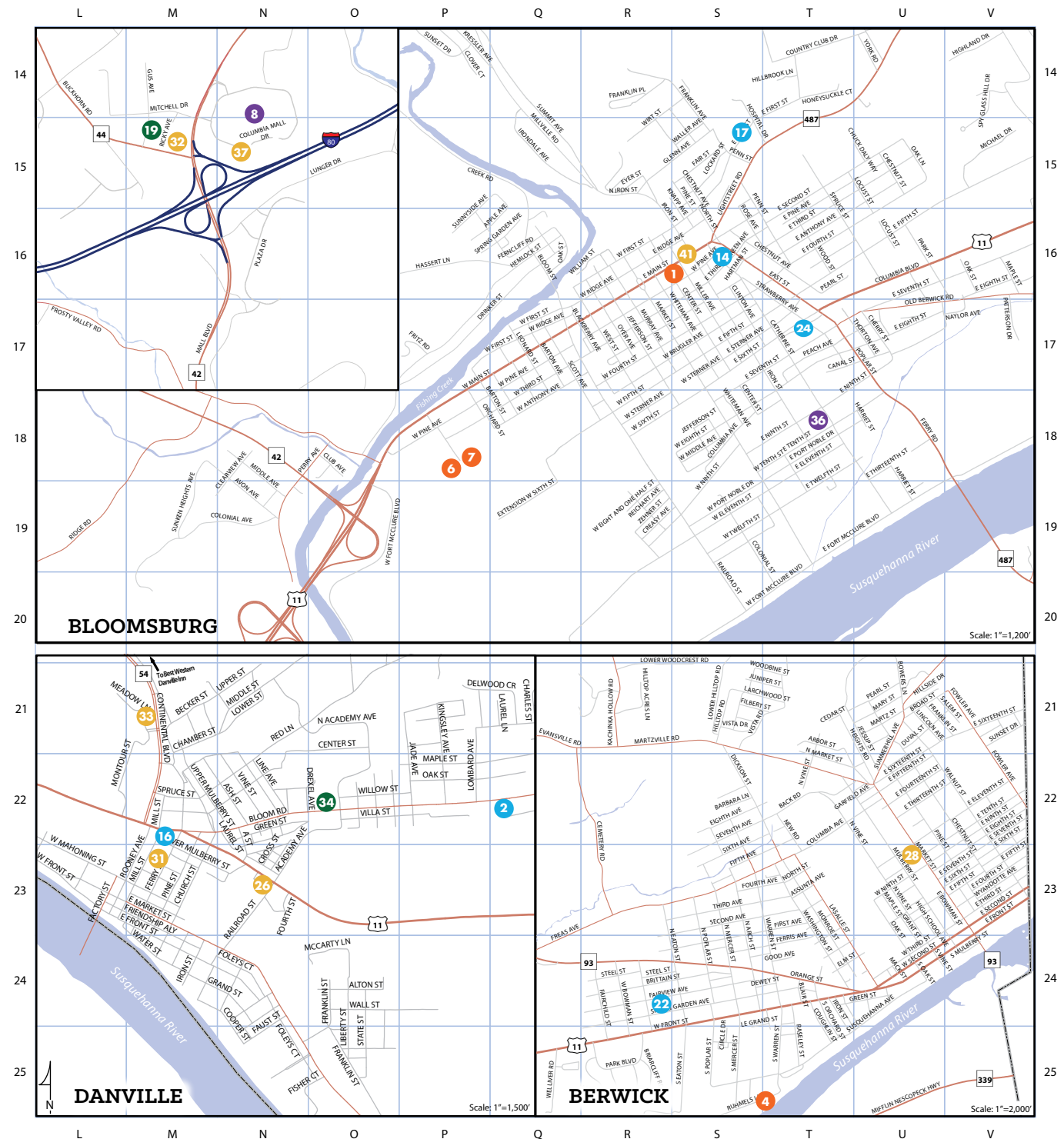

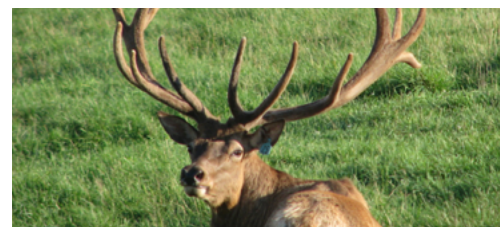

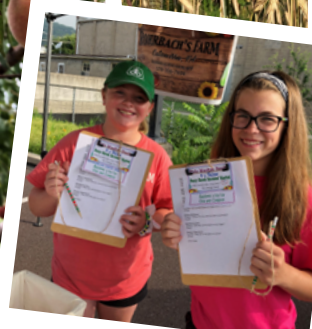

I grew up here in Columbia and Montour Counties. I have known about Rohrbach Farm for 50 years and have watched it evolve and change. I used to visit the store for eggs and milk, or to pick up the occasional present in the Gift Loft. Recently, I have developed a close friendship with the extended family and have a much greater appreciation for all the different aspects of this ever-changing farm. As a Parks and Recreation professional I have enjoyed taking my own kids or our local youth group to the Rohrbach farm for fun activities in the fall, and have encouraged others to do the same. As a musician, I have enjoyed playing music at their festivals and listening to other talented musicians as well. As a farmer, I have had the opportunity to market some of my produce through their store. And as a neighbor I have had the great pleasure of developing a lasting relationship with the entire family, and the farm's many employees Rohrbach exemplifies all that is good about community. Allow me to introduce you to my friends and neighbors.

A visit to Rohrbach has many facets. One could spend a lot of time browsing and shopping in the market. A healthy variety of fruit is grown on the

family farm and the best time to eat it is when it is fresh. Pick up some peaches, cherries, apples or strawberries, or grab some delicious pies or ice-creams that are often made using some of these farm-fresh fruits. Rohrbach has a superb kitchen producing favorites like apple dumplings and whoopie pies. Of course, just like the other fruit pies, these treats are made right there on the farm. Visit with Kay, a third-generation family member as she supervises the rolling of the dough and the filling of the dumplings.

Stroll through the gourmet market and grab a sample of locally grown fruits and vegetables. Some are grown by the Rohrbach family, while others are sourced from nearby farms, but all are of the highest quality. There are also numerous preserved food items such as jellies, fruit, apple butter, pickled vegetables, relishes, sauces and many more delicacies. A deli offers cold cut meats and various cheeses, and Big Dan's BBQ makes ribs, pork, brisket or chicken. The family raises their own hormone-free cattle, so high-quality grass-fed and grain-fed beef is also available for purchase. Top it all off with a local bottle of wine from Freas Farm Winery & Meadery in the

gourmet market. If you meet Denise, a 4th generation family member, she may share with you why she feels it is important to be a part of the local community, providing quality food and supporting local businesses. She is happy to carry on the family tradition.

The upper level of the barn has been restored and redesigned and the Gift Loft now offers a wide range of charming well-crafted décor and gifts for any special occasion. There is also a children's section and an area for hosting small parties and events. Visit with Cathy, a 3rd generation family member, while selecting your soaps or teas and hear the story of how the barn was converted from a place for tractors, chickens and grain to a charming store providing beautiful articles and tasty foods.

The farm market is open spring, summer, and fall. As people have traveled to the region to visit other area tourist attractions, they have made visits to Rohrbach a part of their tradition. Those who visited the farm as kids are now bringing their grandchildren to experience Rohrbach's many seasonal activities. Special outdoor events include weekend festivals in October promoting family friendly and "fright free" activities such as the corn maze, play land, fire pits, picnic pavilions, hay rides and live music.

The family also has a strong commitment to living in the region and continues to explore innovative ideas and new farming methods. They are currently looking into converting to a high-density orchard and implementing no-till cover crop applications to protect the soil. The health of their farm and the continued success of the region as a whole is of the utmost importance to the Rohrbach family, and it shows.

While recently visiting with the Rohrbach family, I was pleased to see the activity that was happening in and around the store. Fifth generation future farmers were helping with chores and tasks, illustrating that this is clearly a family operation with an eye on the future. The shop was bustling with people of all ages and included families, seniors, kids and young couples. There truly is something at the farm for everyone.

A shopper, Maria, happily exclaimed "I need my Rohrbach's fix. I step in here and I know everything is going to be OK!" I can only encourage everyone else to visit - chances are you will agree.

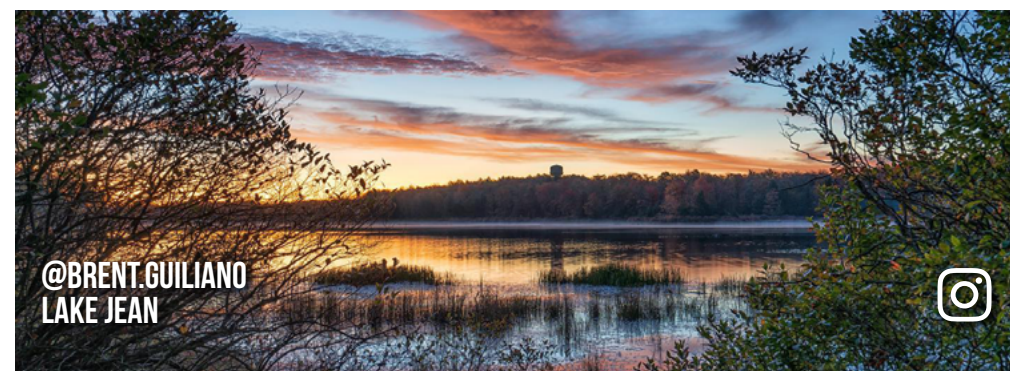

SUMMER HERITAGE PASSPORT

BRINGS HISTORY TO LIFE BY NANCY BISHOP



History might have been a boring subject for some in school, but it comes to life when visiting the historical locations included in Columbia & Montour Counties' Summer Heritage Passport. In 2019, there were 14 choices of places to visit between May and mid-October. In mid-summer, I decided to hit the trail with my passport in hand in search of some unique places. I knew I'd learn a good deal about the rich history of the region along the way.

If you're a nostalgia buff, you won't want to miss Bill's Old Bike Barn on Route 11 between Berwick and Bloomsburg. Bill Morris began his Old Bike Barn in 1998 behind his motorcycle parts shop. Keep your eye out for the large dinosaur statues marking the entrance as you travel Route 11—indicators that this is an interesting stop! Inside the 55,000-square foot building, you'll find Bill's collection of antique motorcycles, including a 1913 Harley Silent Grey Fellow and a 1914 Triumph. But that's not all!



a 30-caliber machine gun and even palm trees with moss hanging from them. Plan to spend several hours and you'll still feel like you haven't had enough time to see everything.

Another one of my stops on the Passport was the Carousel Museum at Knoebels Amusement Resort near Elysburg. If you only think "horses" when you hear about carousel rides, you'll want to visit the Museum, which is in the same building with the Carousel Gift Shop. Among the more than 50 carved carousel figures, some dating back to the 1870s, are tigers, lions, zebras, an ostrich, a giraffe, a reindeer and even a dog, a camel and a rooster.

Next, I took a short drive north to the village of Eagles Mere, where I visited three local museums. The Eagles Mere Museum, located right in town, did a great job of highlighting the town's history. Just down the road, the Eagles Mere Air Museum features more than 30 vintage aircraft dating from 1917 to 1944. Many of the planes are the only remaining flying examples of their kind, and a number were owned by well-



A collector of 1939 New York World's Fair memorabilia, Morris built a little village – Billville – inside the building to house his collection. On Main Street in Billville you'll find a mansion, a toy shop, a camera shop, a smoke shop, a music store and the 1939 New York World's Fair Bar.

To showcase a '45 NOS Military Bike, there's an impressive military display in another room of the building that's complete with a foxhole,



known flying legends. The aircraft are often flown on weekends with good weather to the absolute delight of museum visitors. Right next door, the Eagles Mere Auto Museum contains more than 75 vintage vehicles in pristine condition dating from the 1950s and 1960s. Chevilles, Corvettes, Camaros, Thunderbirds, and even a classic Buick Roadmaster are all on display in this stunning showcase of the golden age of automobile manufacturing. Both museums also have historic memorabilia such as toys, signs, posters and pictures.



Leave time after your visit to the museums for Eagles Mere's shopping and restaurants. The quaint village was a mountain retreat for Philadelphia & New York City elite in the 1800s, and many of the cottages and other buildings are still in use today.

If you'd like your kids to know what it was like to live in a world without TV, cell phones and video games, be sure to make the Barton House at the Bloomsburg Fairgrounds one of the stops on your Passport. It's located on the original part of the Fairgrounds and dates from the mid-1850s. You'll find a one-room schoolhouse among the historic buildings. Each year, the Heritage Passport program kicks off at the Barton House during the "History Comes Alive" event at the Fairgrounds, which features a weekend full of Civil War history, reenactments, and demonstrations. And if you visit during Fair Week in September, you'll find members of the Quilters in Bloom group hard at work on a hand-stitched quilt.

Another stop on the Passport is the Pioneer Tunnel in Ashland. You can take a ride down into an underground anthracite coal mine and also go on an above-ground ride on an old narrow-gauge train. If you visit on a hot summer day, you'll enjoy the natural "air-conditioning" (a chilly 52°) inside the mine!

Other historical stops included the Boyd House, Montgomery House and Mooresburg School in Danville; the Catawissa Quaker Meeting House; the Columbia County Historical & Genealogical Society in Bloomsburg; the International Harvester Collectors Museum in Millville; and the Jane E. DeLong Memorial Hall in Washingtonville. Look for some new locations to be added for 2020.

The Passport was a wonderful experience, and I'd encourage everyone to hit the trail in 2020. It's perfect for families with children or couples looking for something to do on the weekends during the summer. It's also an especially great activity for Scout groups and school groups, as it takes only a visit to five locations for the kids to earn a commemorative Heritage Passport patch. If you're ambitious, you can do 10 of the stops to be entered in a drawing for one of five grand-prize baskets!

In 2020, you can complete the passport between May 8th and October 11th. Passports can be picked up in early May at the Columbia-Montour Visitors Bureau, located at 121 Papermill Road in Bloomsburg, or at any of the participating stops throughout the duration of the summer.

FINDING THE PERFECT TRAIL

FIVE FANTASTIC HIKES FOR 2020

Escaping on a trail is one of the best ways to enjoy the great outdoors during the summer and fall seasons. The Columbia & Montour Counties' region is known far and wide for its outdoor recreation opportunities, including hiking, kayaking, tubing, fishing, boating, hunting, and more. For the trail lovers out there, this article explores five of my favorite area hikes in the peaceful Central Pennsylvania region.

up in wonder at the power of nature as they feel the cool misty breeze coming off the falling water. For those looking to spend the better part of their day exploring the waterfalls and the Glens Natural Area, plan to hike the full 7.2 mile loop. If you'd rather have some time to spend along the beach at nearby Lake Jean, you can plan to hike the shorter 3.2 mile loop and still see 18 of the 21 waterfalls.

If you go: Start from the Lake Rose parking lot and travel down the Ganoga Glen side of the trail to Waters Meet. Then, you can either complete the full 7.2 miles by continuing south toward Route 118, or just head back up the Glen Leigh Side and use the Highland Trail to connect your hike back to Lake Rose. And remember to bring your camera – this is one of the most scenic hikes you'll find on the entire East Coast!

Plan for: 2-3 hours if doing the 3.2 mile loop, 4-5 hours if doing the full 7.2 miles.

IMPORTANT: Bring sturdy hiking shoes and be prepared for some steep trail sections. Hikers on the Falls Trail should be in good physical condition and should exercise caution due to the slippery/wet conditions often found on the trail.

RICKETTS GLEN STATE PARK

Ricketts Glen State Park is one of the standout gems of Pennsylvania, and the popular Falls Trail Loop in the park is one that simply can't be ignored if you're planning to do any hiking this summer. The trail winds through the Glens Natural Area via a series of steep rock staircases and packed dirt paths. The Glens Natural Area is a National Natural Landmark (designated in 1968) whose highlight is the series of 21 free-flowing waterfalls that cascade down through the glen along the trail. The most spectacular is Ganoga Falls, at 94 feet. Hikers can stand near the base of Ganoga Falls and gaze



2 HISTORIC WEISER STATE FOREST MINER TRAILS

Trail Length: Approx. 6 Miles

Weiser State Forest – Roaring Creek Tract provides visitors the opportunity to experience a bit of Pennsylvania history while at the same time enjoying some quality trail time in the woods. Weiser State Forest is home to four historic miner trails from the 19th century that were recently restored to allow for present-day explorers to “walk in the footsteps” of miners from days past.

In the 1800's, coal mines were a main source of work for many Central Pennsylvania inhabitants, and the industry is a big part of the region's history. At the time however, advanced road systems had not been invented. To get to work, miners in parts of today's Columbia County would meet in the early hours of the morning and walk in groups up over the mountain on footpaths into the main production towns of Natalie and Wilburton. Each neighborhood had its own little meeting place in the morning – whether it was at someone's house or just a tree on the edge of town.

Eventually, with the invention of automobiles, a road system came into place. At the same time, as other industries rose and many of the coal mines slowly closed, these once vital paths for miners slowly disappeared into the obscurity of the forest. In 2004, the Roaring Creek and Catawissa Valley Historical Study Group was reviewing old maps of the area, and noticed the old abandoned miner trails. The group approached the Bureau of Forestry to seek permission to reestablish the trails and was granted authorization to do so. With the assistance of local scouts and other volunteers, the group worked diligently for many months to reestablish the trails. In 2005, the trails were completed and a night hike commemorated the project. A group of over 200 people gathered to hike the trails and feel what it was like to be one of the miners that hiked to work in the early morning darkness on those trails almost 200 years prior.

If you go: Today, there are four historic trails that are open for visitors to explore. They are referred to as Natalie #1 East, Natalie #1 West, Natalie #2 and Old Natalie Road. Together, the four trails are approximately six miles in length. In total, Weiser State Forest – Roaring Creek Tract has around 40 miles of shared use trails for hiking, mountain biking, and cross-country skiing.

Plan for: 3-4 hours with potential for more depending on how much you'd like to explore.

3 SUSQUEHANNA WARRIOR TRAIL

Trail Length: 12.5 miles

If you've ever heard the song “Over the River & Through the Woods”, the Susquehanna Warrior Trail embodies it well. The trail starts outside Berwick in the Susquehanna Riverlands Park, and stretches along the banks of the Susquehanna River north to Canal Park in West Nanticoke.

The trail follows the path of an old railroad bed, and going further back into history, an old Native American footpath. The Susquehanna Warrior Trail was constructed in 2007 and takes hikers through quiet stretches of woods, along sections of the river, and even past a drive-in movie theater!

Wildlife is abundant along the trail, and hikers will have a reasonably good chance to see otters, blue herons, groundhogs, bald eagles, and more. The great thing about this trail is that it feels like you're on an old-fashioned adventure the whole time. Set out on the trail in the morning with your picnic lunch and plenty to drink and you'll be well on your way to a full day of quiet solitude.

A good portion of the trail is shaded, and with the occasional river breeze, it makes for a great summer or early fall hike. The trail is open for hikers and bicyclists alike, and is mainly comprised of a finely crushed stone surface. Along the way, you will pass through the small village of Shickshinny. The trail enters Shickshinny Park and continues left onto East Butler Street, where it resumes down East Vine Street and across a small footbridge crossing Shickshinny Creek. If you need to grab a bite to eat or restock on your water supply, Shickshinny is your best bet.

If you go: Parking for the southern trailhead is in the Susquehanna Riverlands Park along State Route 11. Parking for the northern trailhead in Hunlock Creek is directly adjacent to the Garden Drive-In; turn into the drive-in entrance and look for signs for the Susquehanna Warrior Trail.

Plan for: A full day hike along the river; the trail is 12.5 miles one way, so a car parked at each trailhead might be a good idea.

5 J. MANLEY ROBBINS RAIL TRAIL

Trail Length: 3.8 miles

The J. Manley Robbins Trail is a former railroad line for the "Montour," a 10-ton narrow gauge locomotive used for carrying iron ore between local deposits and furnaces. The line was converted to a bicycle path in the 1890's by a club of local bicycle enthusiasts, and is believed to be the oldest rail trail in the United States.



The trail also connects with additional trails and recreation amenities at the Hess Field Complex. After walking the first portion of the trail that runs parallel to State Route 54 (and crosses a small covered bridge), it winds through a beautiful stretch of deciduous forest above Mahoning Creek. The enjoyable 3.8 mile loop is a multi-purpose trail that accommodates bicyclists and walkers of all ages. Dogs are allowed, if they are leashed.

If you go: If you're coming into Danville on State Rt. 54 from Interstate 80, turn right onto Route 642 (Liberty Valley Road) and make an immediate left onto a dirt road/parking area. This is the J. Manley Robbins trailhead. Further down the trail, the Hess Recreation Area has several fields and a pavilion that can seat up to 75 people.

Plan for: 1.5 to 2 hours to walk the trail.

4 MONTOUR PRESERVE'S GOOSE WOODS TRAIL

Trail Length: 0.9 miles

The Goose Woods Trail at the Montour Preserve is a naturalist's dream. Although short, trail goers could spend hours wandering the trail looking at wildflowers, insects, pond life, small woodland dwellers, and animal tracks by the creek. Goose Woods Trail is great for families with children or the elderly, as it is short in distance and almost completely flat. Plus, children will love exploring the forest!

Goose Woods Trail is also a great place to bring a nature journal or camera. You can find a comfortable spot just off the trail to sit and journal about the sounds, sights, and small details of the natural world around you. Or perhaps a camera is more your speed; photograph birds, spiders, flowers, or practice taking some landscapes by the creek.

Learn about the different types of trees, leaves, and animal tracks, and see if you can spot a scarlet tanager or red-winged blackbird flying from tree to tree. Along the way, you'll pass the Preserve's Sugar Shack, where maple sugar is made in the early part of each year.

If you go: The Preserve is open dawn until dusk daily. Be sure to visit the education center and learn about some of the animals and plants you might see during your visit. For those looking for additional hiking beyond the Goose Woods Trail, the Chillisuagi Trail that circles the 165-acre Lake Chillisquaque is approximately 3.8 miles long. Bring a picnic lunch and spend some quality time enjoying the lake!

Plan for: As much or as little time as you'd like to spend exploring the Preserve.

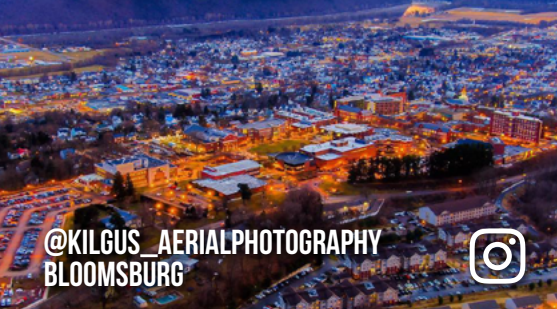

A SPECIAL CAMP FOR SPECIAL KIDS

During the summer of 1986, Lois and Dennis Wolff shared a dream with a few close friends. Having been born with a life-threatening liver disease, their son, Nicholas, was recovering from a liver transplant at just 18 months of age. During that trying time, the Wolff family realized the value of having a place to connect with other families going through a similar experience by sharing their struggles and triumphs. The Wolffs decided to donate 35 acres of their farmland in Millville, PA to create that place. When their friends agreed to pitch in and help, Camp Victory, a "Special Camp for Special Kids," was born.

After several years of hard work and dedication, the Camp was finally ready to host its first residential campers in the summer of 1994. In the following 25 years, Camp Victory has grown steadily into the impressive facility and program it is today and has hosted nearly 30,000 overnight campers and counselors. Partnering with 30 independent groups, Camp Victory offers the unique location and programming each group needs to successfully host their camp. When partner groups sign on, they choose from a variety of options, including program activities like archery, waterfront, challenge course and arts and crafts.

Camp Victory provides all staffing for food service, waterfront, arts and crafts, maintenance and facility, and the challenge course. Each camp provides its own cabin counselors and specialized medical staff. Campers get a true camping experience while still receiving unique attention and special care during their stay.



Camp Victory is not just the physical camp where special kids come to have a fun time, but it's also a magical place where special people come to grow in spirit, accomplish goals, heal and leave with renewed confidence and determination. A young child can come to Camp Victory battling an illness, feeling afraid of being separated from family and uncertain about their future. However, after a week's stay at camp, that same child can be positively changed for life.



ERICA'S STORY

In November 2010, a 7-year old named Erica Miller was diagnosed with Acute Lymphocytic Leukemia (ALL). ALL is the most common childhood cancer. For Erica, cancer treatments resulted in many hospital visits and stays. While at Geisinger's oncology clinic, doctors and child life specialists told Erica about "Camp Dost", one of Camp Victory's partner group camps. At first, Erica did not want to attend, nor did she want her mom, Jayleen, to leave her alone.

However, it did not take long for the magic and love from wonderful counselors and previous campers, (who also battled illnesses and similar feelings) to show Erica that by attending camp, she would become part of a family and would experience a week of unforgettable adventure. After meeting new friends and enjoying a variety of activities, the hardest part about going to camp for Erica was leaving.

Erica continued attending Camp Dost at Camp Victory for 10 years until her camp graduation in 2017. She has been off chemotherapy since 2012. Being a graduate was a bittersweet accomplishment for this cancer survivor. It meant leaving the special family that helped her grow, heal and succeed. Erica's time away will be short, however, as she plans to return to Camp Dost as a counselor as soon as she is eligible.

Until Erica returns as a counselor, she has found another way to be a part of Camp Victory's magic. She is now a certified lifeguard and a Camp Victory employee! She hopes to help campers have a safe experience and make magical memories. In the future, Erica would like to work in the medical field, possibly with genetics. Wouldn't it be wonderful to have "Dr. Erica Miller" visit Camp Victory in a few years and share her success story with other timid little 7-year olds!



Each year from spring to fall, Camp Victory hosts various camps; one week for cancer survivors like Erica, a week for kids with heart disease, diabetes, spina bifida, autism, and many more. The Camp is accessible for all abilities - the treehouse has a ramp, the zip line and rock-climbing wall have adaptive harnesses, the swimming pool has a lift and a ramp, and the camp paths are paved. There's a Med Shed where campers can have any medical needs addressed - even chemo.
